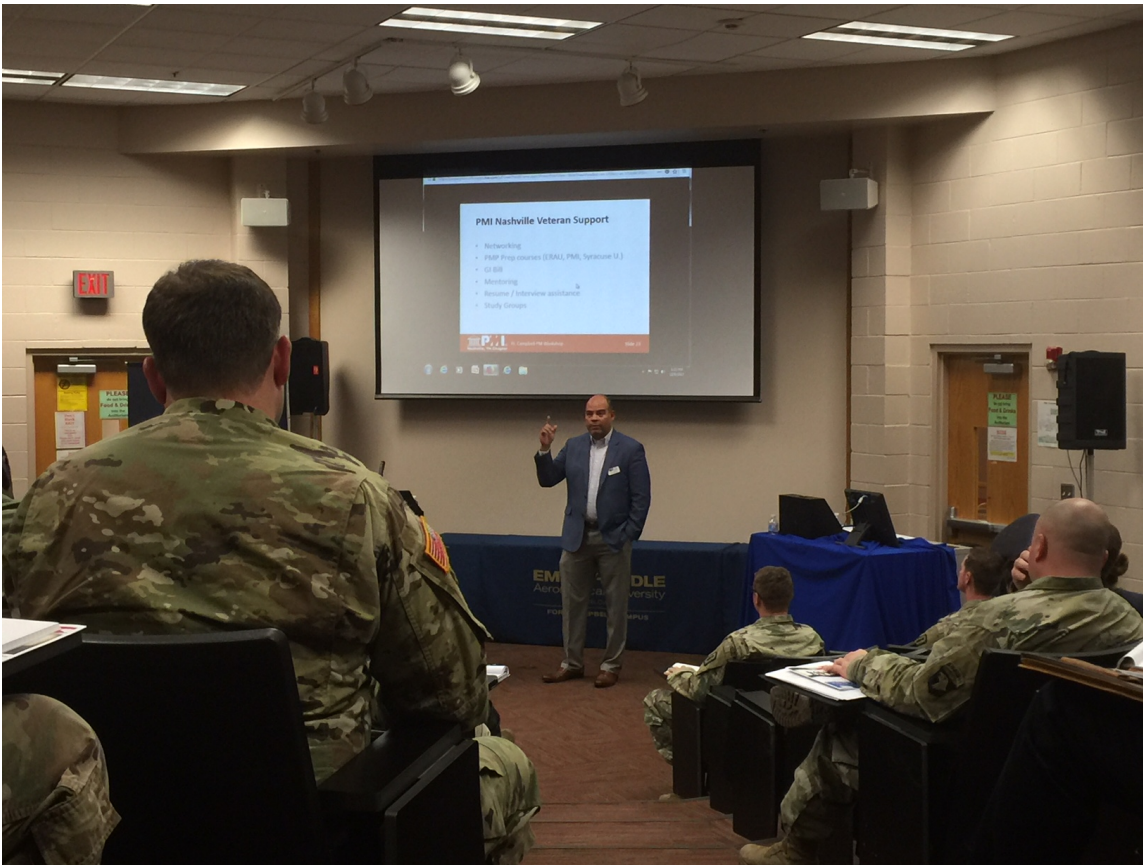


PMI Nashville Supports Veteran Transition to the Project Management Profession
