Three Keys to Career Success

- Know yourself

 - Consider other factors (commute time, etc...)
 - Perform a self-assessment
 - Ask your friends
 - Take an assessment
 - Understand how you are wired and designed

Three Keys to Career Success

- 2. Develop a solid plan
 - Evaluate your current occupation / work environment
 - Determine if you need additional education / certifications
 - If you need to make a career change, consider occupations "right next door"
 - ABOVE ALL Align how you are wired and designed with your work

Three Keys to Career Success

- 3. Evaluate and adjust
