As data becomes more important and ubiquitous, privacy issues are coming to the forefront. News of data breaches and dark data practices (e.g. Cambridge Analytica) is an almost daily occurrence as data is collected and aggregated in commercial markets through a variety of user-inputs, device telemetry, sensor driven collection and other technologies – without necessary and appropriate data privacy and security controls.

This dynamic and increasingly critical complex of data-related issues compels the continual development and deployment of security and privacy requirements, standards and activities for governments and private sector organizations.

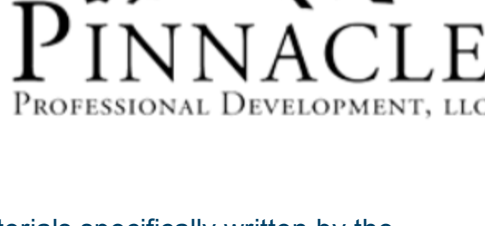
Privacy by Design involves identifying privacy risks and goals and engineering those goals, requirements, technologies and techniques into processes and solutions that protect privacy throughout the data lifecycle.

Privacy by Default is a fundamental individual and organizational orientation towards data, understanding of the basic regarding data use regulations and professional standards, and incorporation of data respectful practices into organizational culture and operations.


