After action reviews (AARs) are an important part of improving a process and closing out a project. But too often, project managers either don't do them at all or get limited amounts of useful information during an AAR. A well planned out and effectively executed AAR will grow the organization and build better relationships. It is the ultimate form of feedback at the team or project level. The US Military is often identified as the best illustration of how to conduct AARs effectively. The discussion is based on this experience, but focused on project managers and leaders.
